
## GARDENS AND CUL-DE-SACS

## Walk Itinerary

## Initial meeting point at 10:30 am at the TANNER'S BRIDGE

BASES	DIRECTIONS OF PENETRATION
We walk East along the Zhan D' Ark Boulevard	
Turn left at Fadil Rada St.	We walk on the left along the street, leaving behind on the right Robert Nol St., and we complete a sort of a circle, passing through the tunnel of the yellow building and ending up in a cul-de-sac.
We get out at Tefta Tashko Koço St.	We will walk in and out a series of cul-de-sacs:
	1 – From the point of exit we turn left, toward the New Bazaar. We walk in the first cul-de-sac on the left. We will stop to look at the Italian-inspired villa with oriental-inspired ornaments under the roof.
	2 – We will turn at Tefta Tashko Koço St. leaving behind the New Bazaar. Keeping on the left we will penetrate somewhere near Musa Karapici St.




	We see the ruins of the Italian-inspired villa that is Tirana's first High School, Ismail Qemail, in Tefta Tashko Koço St. no. 38.
	3 – Turn at Tashko Koço St. to continue walking in and out of the cul-de-sac on the left of building no. 40
	4 – In Tashko Koço St. we turn on the left (just before Xhangolli supermarket). We trace a U shape.
We turn at Tashko Koco St. to continue along Vllazën Huta St. up to the Vila e Tartufit place	We penetrate into a series of cul-de-sacs:
	1 – On the right, in front of Vila e Tartufit place we take an alley that ends in a parking space/urban garden and penetrate through a tight space between buildings.
	2 – We exit through the end of Vllazën Huta St., and we enter the cul-de-sac of the parking place, on our lefts.
	3 – The cul-de-sac near Vila e Tartufit, on our left.
	4 – The cul-de-sac near Vila Çeti, on our left.



Walk along Vllazën Huta St. now perpendicularly to the Zhan D' Ark Boulevard	We walk in and out of two consecutive cul-de-sacs on our right.
We exit at Hoxha Tasim St.	Turn right.
	We continue on the right and explore the cul-de-sac in Musa Vathi St.
	We cross the street.
Walk upwards in Riza Cerova St.	
Pass to Qemal Stafa St.	At the exit point of the street we continue on the left to walk up Hilë Mosi St.
	We exit at Dervish Hekali St. and there we trace an O-shape to get to Vera and Lili's villa, which is built in 1828 and will be soon torn down to make space for a new apartment building.



From Dervish Hekali St.	We walk West. Turn left at At Shtjefën Gjeçovi St. We keep on walking to Ludovik Shllaku St. (as the road sign says, but which appears Deko Rusi St., on Google Maps).
We turn to Qemal Stafa St.	Walk on the left.
	We get inside the garden space on the old Italian villa that is used as a parking lot to explore.
	We continue in Qemal Stafa St. to turn at the cul-de-sac in Musa Maci St.
	We pass through the tunnel to get at Xhemal Tafaj St.



	We continue through alleys to exit at Ali Pashë Gucia St.
	We turn right at Shaqar Oshafi St.
	In Thanas Ziko St. we will turn right of the parking and washing space in front of us to walk through the long cul-de-sac in Jorgii Jorgoni St., and its offshoots.
	On our way back we exit on our left 4 Dëshmorët St.
We exit at 4 Dëshmorët St.	Enter Hafëz Ibrahim Dalliu St. We walk through the numerous culde-sacs and through the last vernacular stone-paved alleyway in Tirana.
We exit at Dibra St.
